

Description


This technical document will go through step by steps on how to install the product key as well as the firmware for the SE-emulator. When reviewing this document there will be some places that will have “Notes” and “Tech Notes”, this will help with any trouble shooting that may come up. That is why they were add (Most common issues), Let’s Begin.

Step 1

Launch emulator, by click on the *.exe file should launch emulator.


Step 2

You will get an error stating the following:



This error states that the software you are going to run on this system may cause issues with your security. Please click on “More Info”.


Once you click on more information, a window will change. The window will now allow you to be able to run this software, click on the “Run anyways” button.



Please NOTE! This will not be adding any addition security to your system, nor will this change the security on your system. No infections have been found then running this application (app).

Step 3

Once your software launch's correctly, then you should see a window of the emulator that you have download, see below



This window will be your default (desktop) window for your emulator software. Here is where you would choose what game to play and set specific setting you want setup.


Error box in the middle (Will not allow you do anything with it until you click on the “OK” button, states there is no “Key” missing for encryption.

Step 4

Click on the “OK button, then we will start the process on installing prokey and firmware.

Step 5

You should be at this point of the app launch.




So, a few configurations need to be at this point, they are

1. Install Prokey in app
 - a. Download prokey from our website
2. Install firmware in app
 - a. Download firmware from our website

Keep in mind when your downloading from our website the prokey and the firmware, you will have a list of different firmware and prokey versions, I would use the last one (at this time 20.3), and these files will be in a “Zip” format to download.

Step 6

Once firmware and prokey has been download, go ahead and extract both them. Once you get them extracted, go back to the screen above (See step 5). Once there, look at the menu at the top of the screen.



Follow the following steps to install prodkey and firmware:


1. Click on the “Tools” menu
 - a. A window will drop down, click on “Install decryption key” menu
 - i. A window will pop up, you will need to show where your key is (This is the prodkey you download in the zip file and extracted to a folder).
 - ii. Once you show it the prodkey file, it will start the process to upload. Once the upload is done, it’ll say complete.
 - iii. You have installed your prodkey.
2. Click on the “Tools” menu again
 - a. A window will drop down, click on the “Install firmware” menu.
 - i. A window will pop up, you will need to show where your firmware (this is the firmware file you download and then extract) folder.
 - ii. Once you show it where the firmware folder is, it will start the process to upload. Once the upload is done, it’ll say complete.
 - iii. You have installed your firmware.

Step 7

Almost complete, now we have to take the rom games (this game has been downloaded to your pc already), and let the software know where the games are at to play.

Best rule of thumb is to make a folder called “Switch Roms”, and once you download a switch rom game (*.nsp or *.xci), then put the file into this folder.

Click on the “Yellow folder with a green plus” right in the middle of the screen of your switch emulator software.



A window will come up asking you where your default folder is for all your games in it. This is where you would navigate to the folder you called “Switch Roms”.

Once you show it the folder, then click “Save” button.

Step 8


If everything went well, then you should see the list games you have download for the switch. Double clicks on the game you want to play and start playing the game.

Tech Note!!

Controller may need to be setup (if your using a Xbox, PS5 device), then does need to be setup in the emulator itself. If not, you're not going to have any way to control the game.

Installing a controller in app.


1. In the menu in the app, click on “Emulation” menu
2. Then click on “configuration” menu
3. Once in the configuration menu, click on the tab that says “Input”



4. Once in this menu, us the drop boxes that are labeled “Keyboard”, click on that drop box and click on “Xbox game controller or PS game controller”. (NOTE... Make sure the game controller you want is setup in the Bluetooth on the gaming device this app is running on). Then click on the “Save” button and then the “ok button at the bottom of the screen.
5. You now should be configured to use the controller you want with this app. If you launch a game and the controller still doesn’t work. Leave the game launch and go though these steps again to configure the controller for that game.

Step 9 Trouble shooting!! (this step is only if you do not see your games)

If you get a screen that looks like this below



This means the prodkey did not work. You will have to follow steps again to install the prodkey to the software. Once you get the right prokey installed, then you should be able to go back to step 8.

Tech Note!!!

Keep in mind in understand “prodkey” for this emulator. Newest prodkey should work for any games. Older prodkey “14,15,16 and so on” may work with some games (which the game will appear in the app window above) and others don’t. So, it will be trial and error on getting the correct prodkey to work. That’s why we always recommend to use the latest prodkey.
